Portfolio Manager Commentary

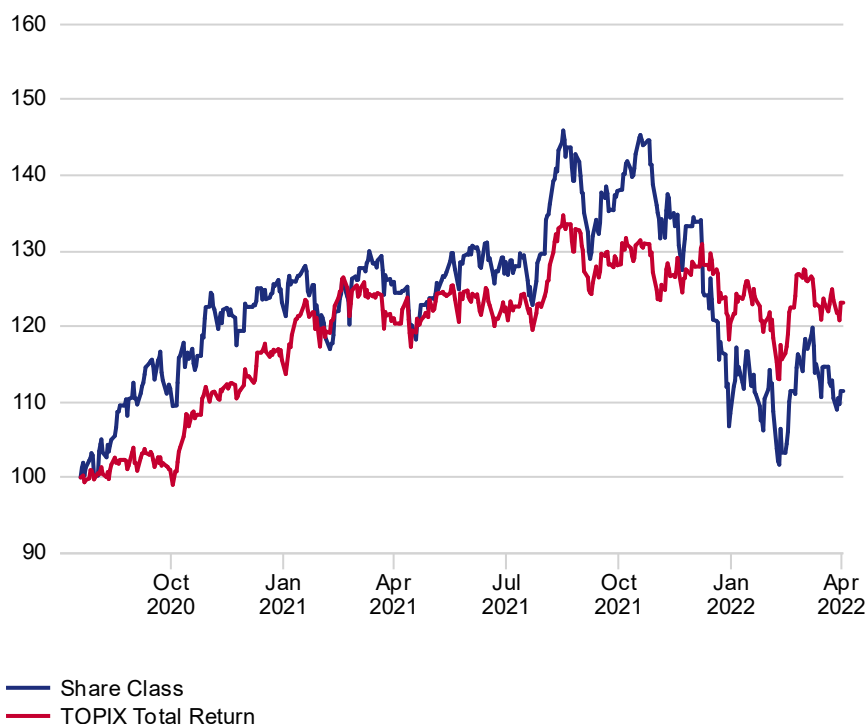
Performance Overview

Major positive contributors were Japan Material (special gas supply for semiconductor and LCD plants), Management Solutions (project management for corporate DX), and Hioki E.E. (electric measuring instruments). In contrast, PR TIMES (press release distribution website) fell on modest earnings guidance and Meiko Electronics (printed wiring boards for automotive and smartphone markets) also dropped on concerns over the negative impact of the lockdown in China. Money Forward (cloud based accounting services provider) retreated from an earlier rally.

Market Outlook and Investment Strategy

We believe that the Japanese stock market will gradually stabilise along with the progress in the development of a treatment for COVID as well as even more attractive valuations resulting from recent share price corrections, although we need to pay attentions to tighter US monetary policy and intensifying geopolitical risks. In terms of portfolio strategy, we would highlight new growth areas such as the metaverse that are expected grow along with 5G technology. DX-related investment, which is one of the focal points of this strategy, has expanded from non-manufacturing sectors to manufacturing and SMEs. We also focus on the spread of environment-friendly vehicles with the introduction of ADAS in cars. In addition, we are paying attention to the introduction of IoT to improve productivity through the use of cloud systems. On the other hand, we are mindful of uncertainty in emerging markets, and the impact of higher material costs on corporate earnings on an individual company basis.

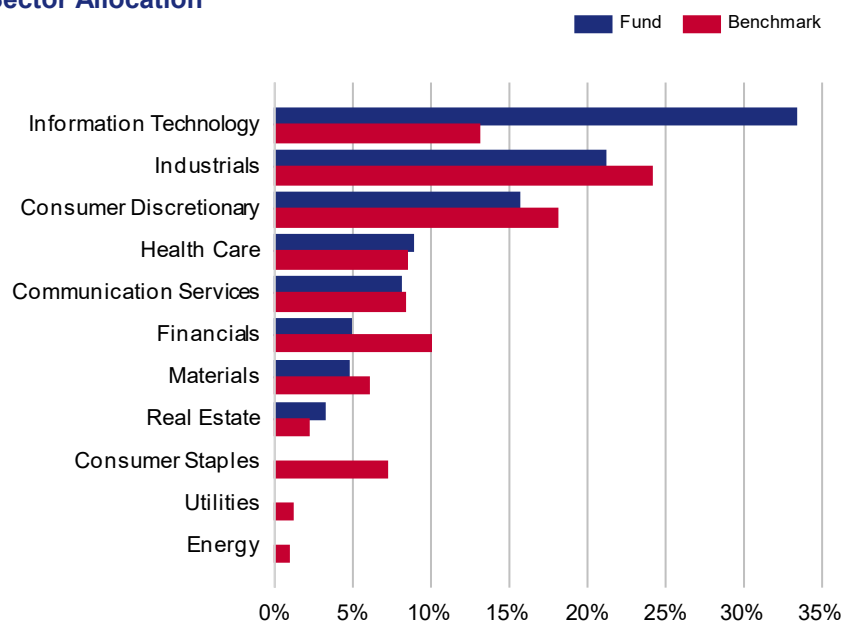
